FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

WOF = width of fabric USE A QUARTER INCH SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT

QUILT TOP

- Fabric 1 Dark (Black) 1 yard
- Fabric 2 Light (Floral) 1 yard
- Fabric 3 Medium (Orange) 1 yard

NOTE: The backing/batting sizes allow for an extra 4" on all sides - for heavy quilting add more.

BATTING

• 1 pc measuring 65" x 65"

BACKING

• 1 pc measuring 65" x 65"

BINDING

• %" yard

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

QUILT TOP

- From Fabric 1 (Dark) cut 3 strips 10" x WOF
- From Fabric 2 (Light) cut 3 strips 10" x WOF
- From Fabric 3 (Medium) cut 3 strips 10" x WOF

BINDING

• Cut 6 strips measuring 21/4" x WOF



STEP 1

Sew your strips into lots of 3 as follows:

- Strip-set 1 Fabric 1, Fabric 2, Fabric 3
- Strip-set 2 Fabric 3, Fabric 1, Fabric 2
- Strip-set 3 Fabric 2, Fabric 3, Fabric 1

STRIP-SET 1



STRIP-SET 2




STRIP-SET 3



STEP 2



Sub-cut each strip set into 4 pieces each measuring 10".



You should now have:

- 4 blocks from strip-set 1
- 4 blocks from strip-set 2
- 4 blocks from strip-set 3



STEP 3

Lay out the blocks as shown below and sew together to form the quilt top.



Add your backing and batting and quilt.

Add binding to complete the quilt.
