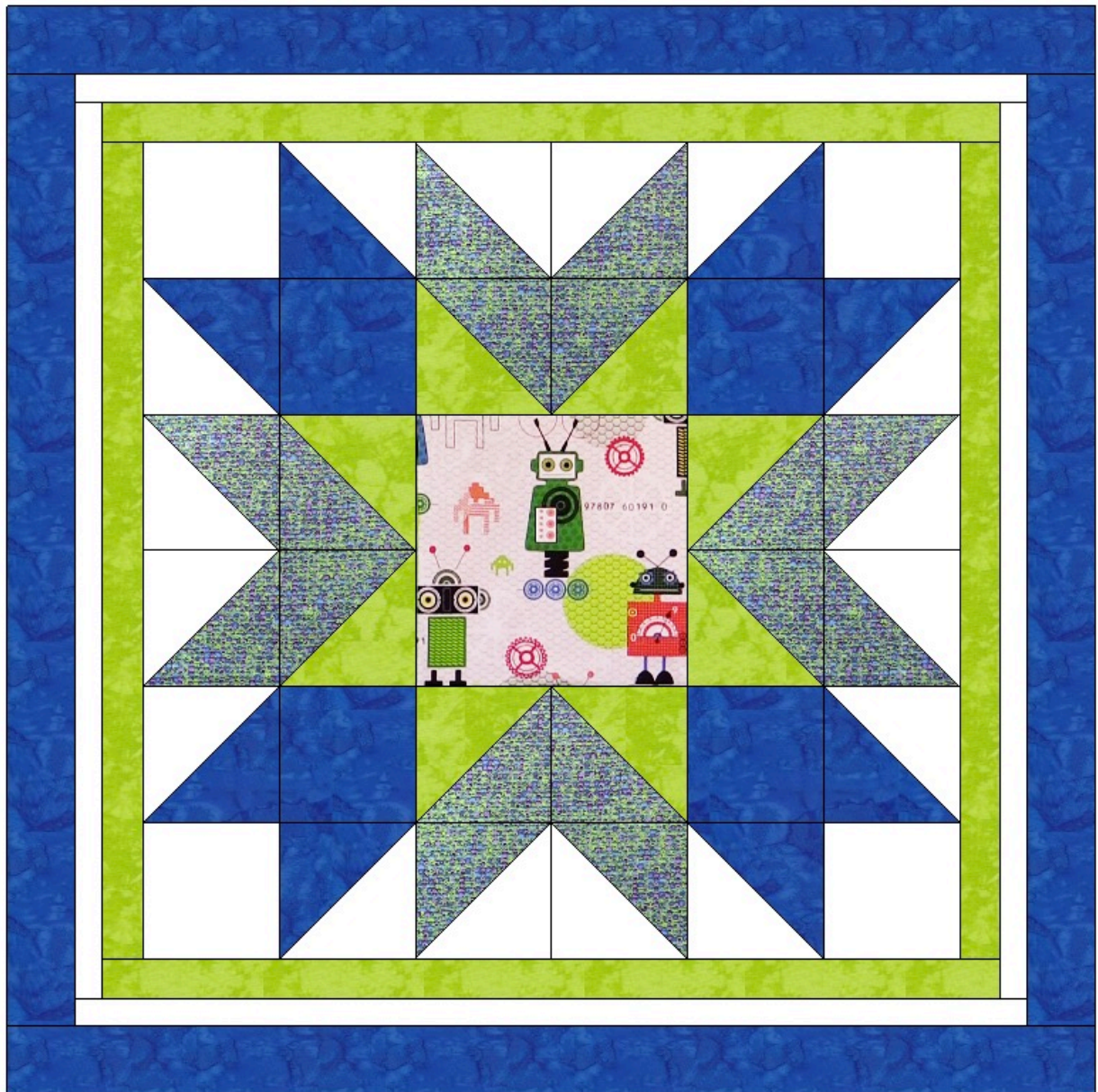


Blueberry Pie Quilt

Finished quilt size - approx 40 " x 40 "

These instructions are to help you finish the quilt shown in the Blueberry Quilt Block tutorial on Alanda Craft.



Fabric Requirements

- ❖ Fabric 1 (Center Feature Square) - 10 ½" x 10 ½"
- ❖ Fabric 2 (White) - ⅝ yard
- ❖ Fabric 3 (Blue) - ¾ yard
- ❖ Fabric 4 (Green mottled) - ½ yard
- ❖ Fabric 5 (Light green) - ½ yard
- ❖ Binding - ⅓ yard (based on 2¼" binding strip)
- ❖ Batting - the batting size is 48" x 48" - this will give you an extra 4" on all sides to cover the quilting.
- ❖ Backing fabric - the backing size is 48" x 48" - this will give you an extra 4" on all sides to cover the quilting.

Block Cutting Instructions

- Centre feature square - Cut 1pc @ 10 ½" x 10 ½"
- White fabric - Cut 4pcs @ 5 ½" x 5 ½" AND 8pcs @ 6" x 6"
- Blue fabric - Cut 4pcs @ 5 ½" x 5 ½" AND 4pcs @ 6" x 6"
- Green mottled fabric - Cut 8pcs @ 6" x 6"
- Light green fabric - Cut 4pcs @ 6" x 6"

Borders Cutting Instructions

- Border 1 (Light green)
 - Cut 2 strips - 30 ½" x 2"
 - Cut 2 strips - 33 ½" x 2"
- Border 2 (White)
 - Cut 2 strips - 33 ½" x 1 ½"
 - Cut 2 strips - 35 ½" x 1 ½"
- Border 3 (Blue)
 - Cut 2 strips - 35 ½" x 3"
 - Cut 2 strips - 40 ½" x 3"

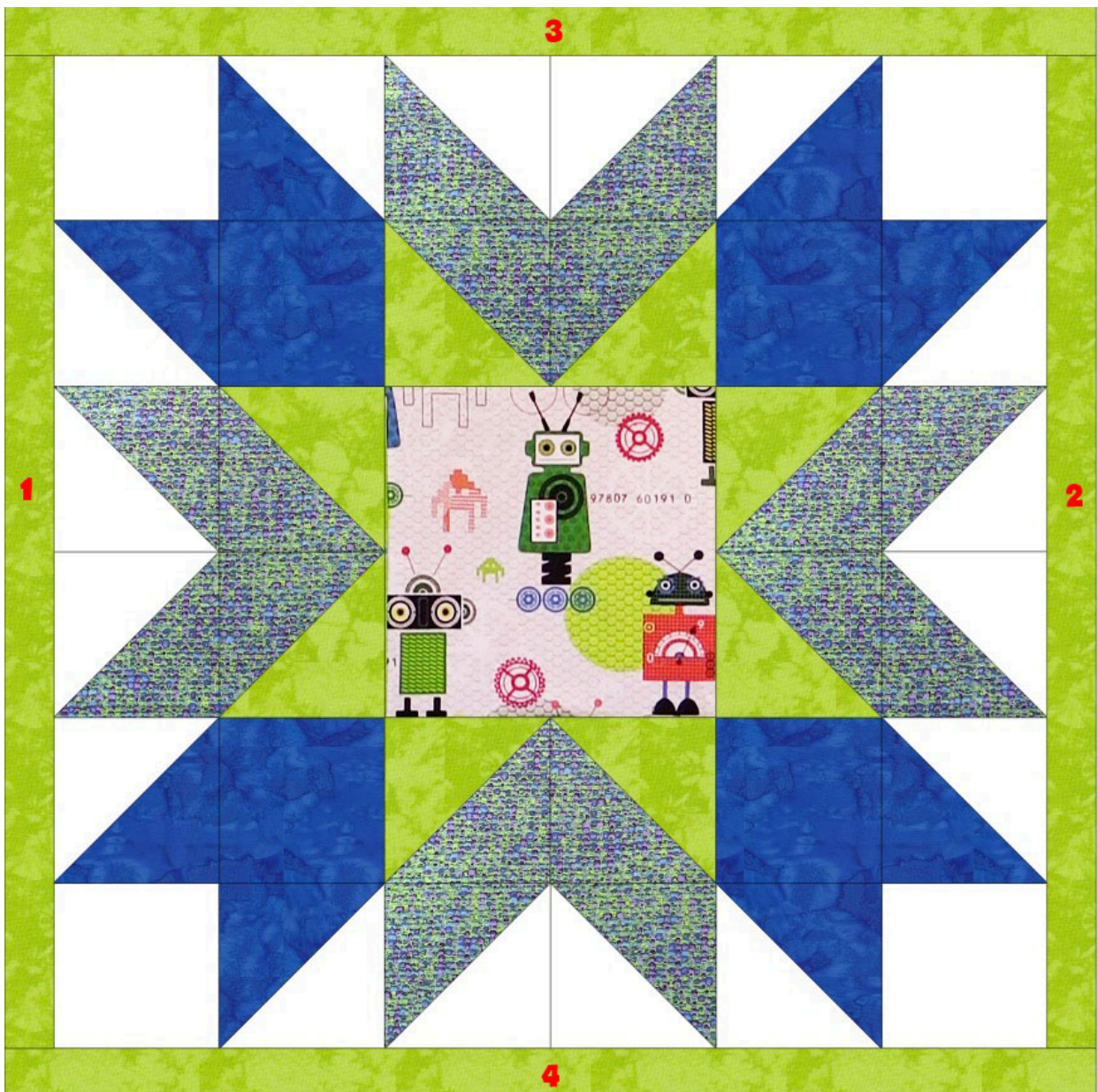
Assembly

Quarter Inch Seam Used

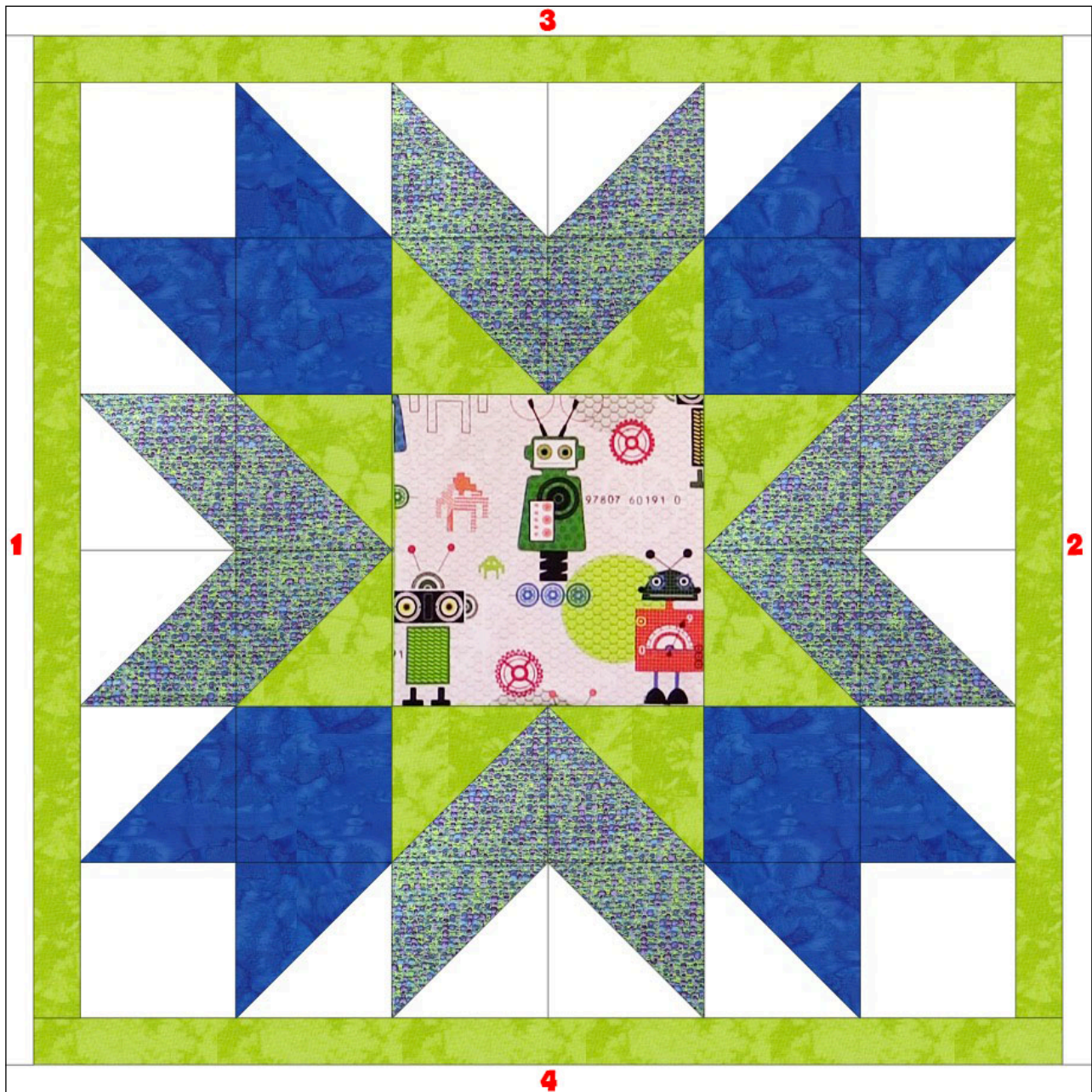
1. To create the blocks, follow the instructions at alandcraft.com

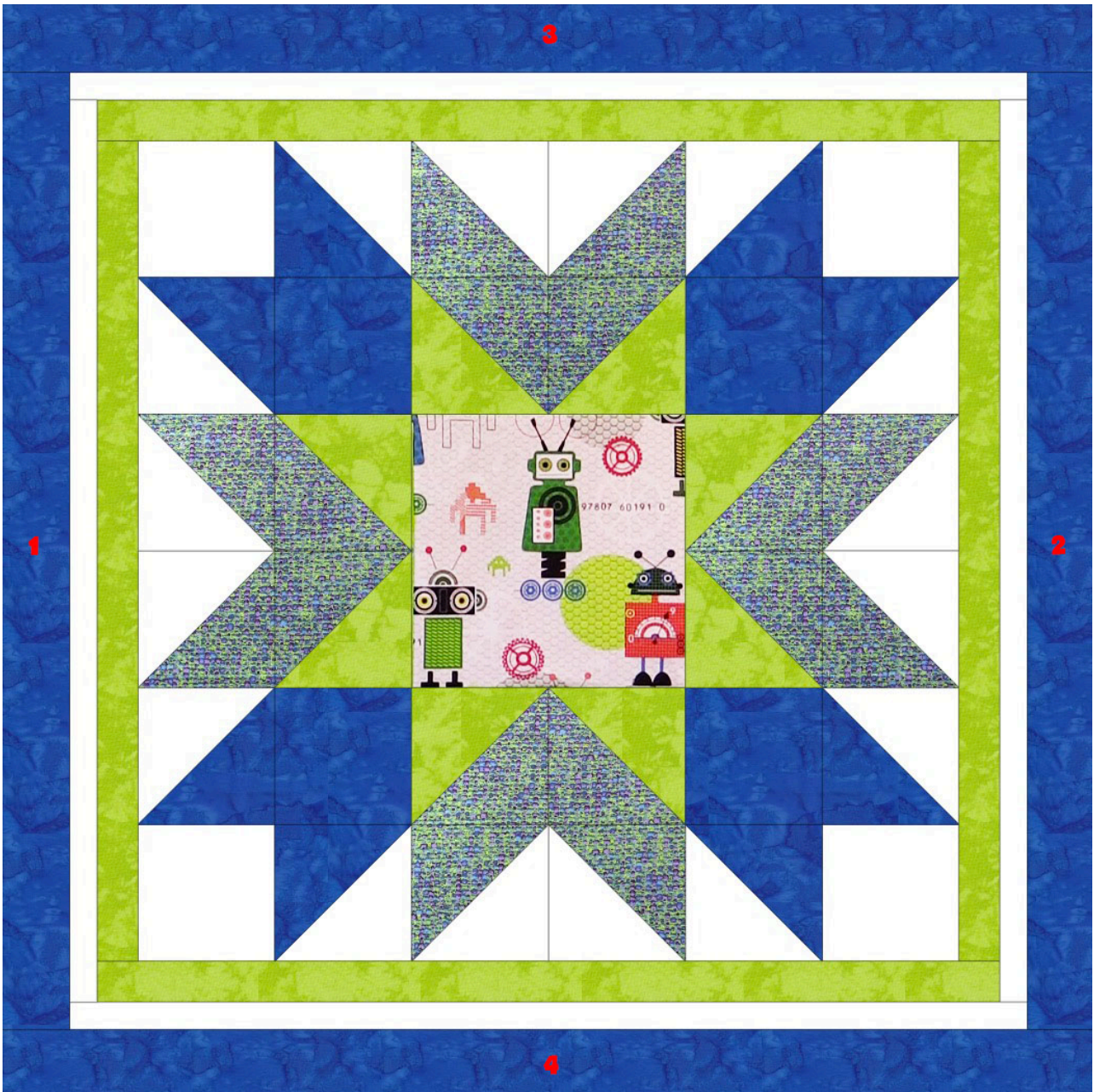
2. Once the block is completed, sew the light green border strips to it in the order shown in the image below.



2. Sew the white border strips in the order shown in the image below.



3. Sew the blue border strips in the order shown in the image below.



4. Add the batting and backing and quilt as desired.
