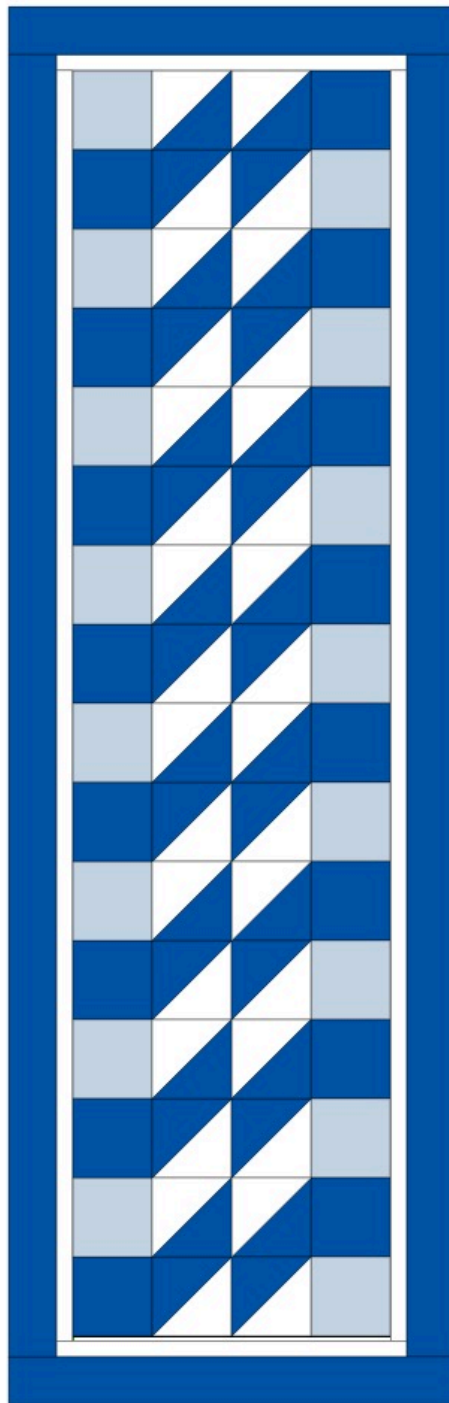

Finished table runner size - approx 14 " x 44 "



Fabric Requirements

Fabric 1 (Dark Blue) - ½ yard

Fabric 2 (White) - ½ yard

Fabric 3 (Light Blue) - ¼ yard

Backing Fabric - 1 ½ yards

Binding - ¼ yard (based on 2¼" binding strip)

Batting size - approx 48" x 19"

Block Cutting Instructions

These instructions are for an 10" x 10" finished block (10½" x 10½" unfinished block).

To make the four blocks cut the following:

- Fabric 1 (dark blue): Cut 16 pieces at 3" x 3"
- Fabric 1 (dark blue): Cut 8 pieces at 5" x 5"
- Fabric 2 (white): Cut 8 pieces at 5" x 5"
- Fabric 3 (light blue): Cut 16 pieces at 3" x 3"

Borders Cutting Instructions

- Border 1 (White)
 - Cut 2 strips - 1" x 40½"
 - Cut 2 strips - 1" x 11½"
- Border 2 (Dark Blue)
 - Cut 2 strips - 2" x 41½"
 - Cut 2 strips - 2" x 14½"

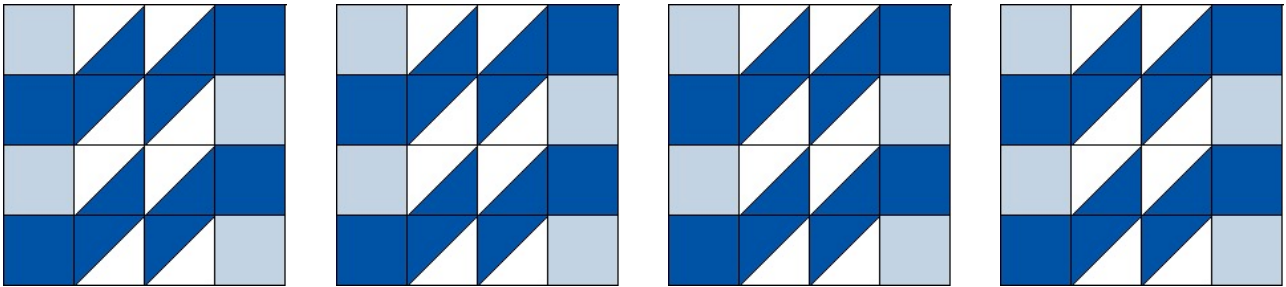
Assembly

Quarter Inch Seam Used

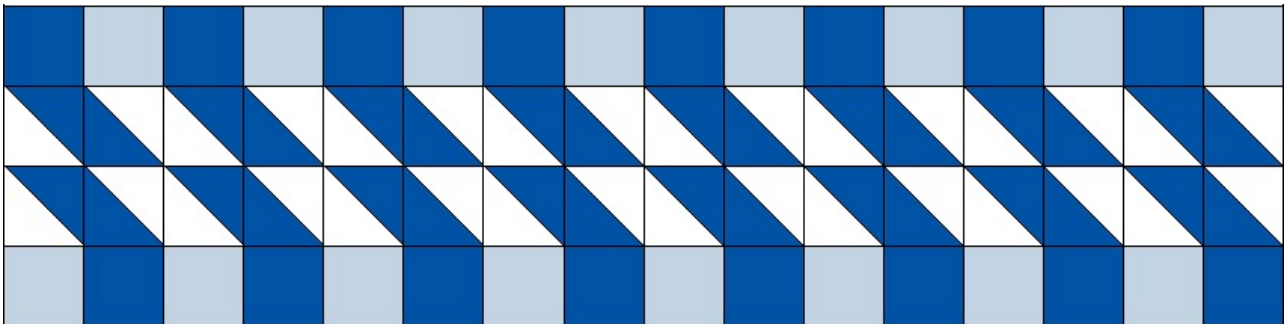
1. To create the blocks, follow the instructions at alandcraft.com

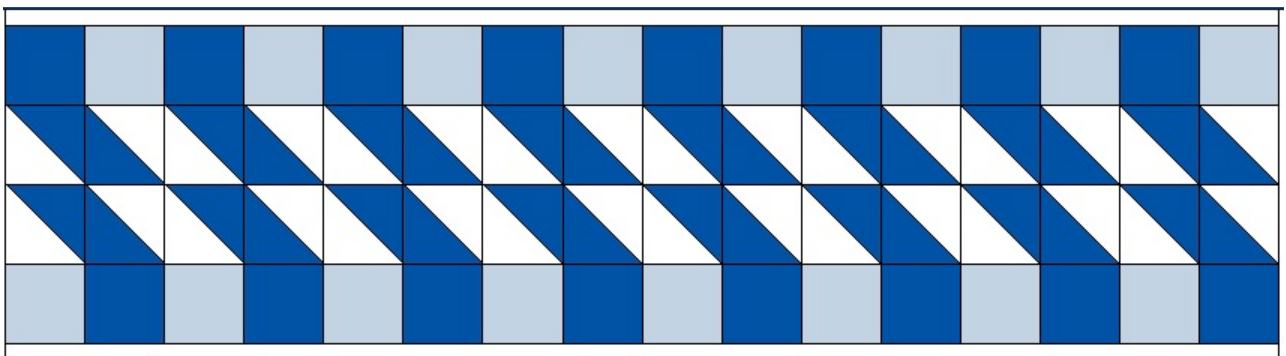
You will end up with 4 blocks.



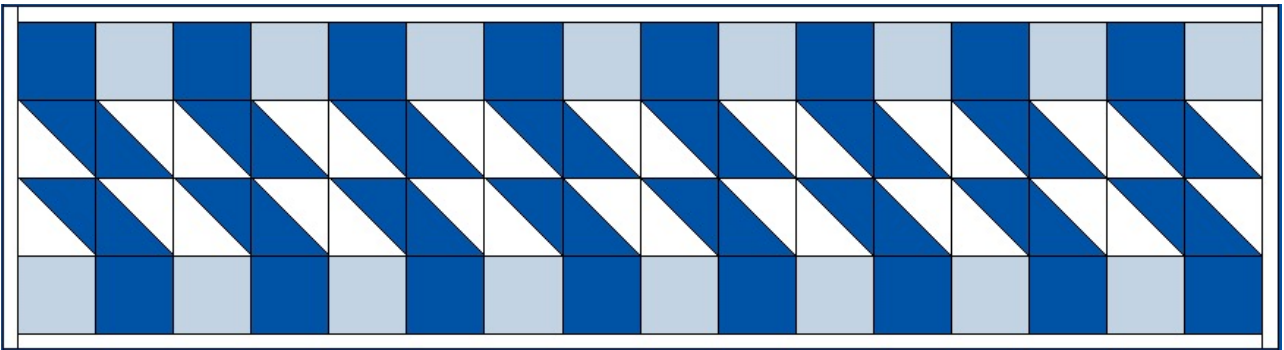
2. Sew the 4 blocks together to form the main section of the table runner.



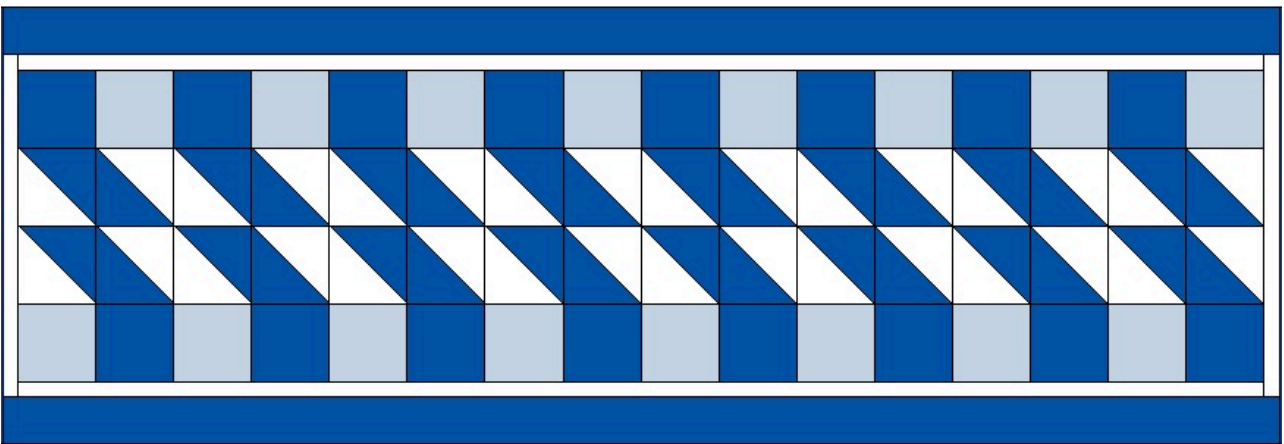
3. Sew the long (white) border strips to the long sides of the block strip.



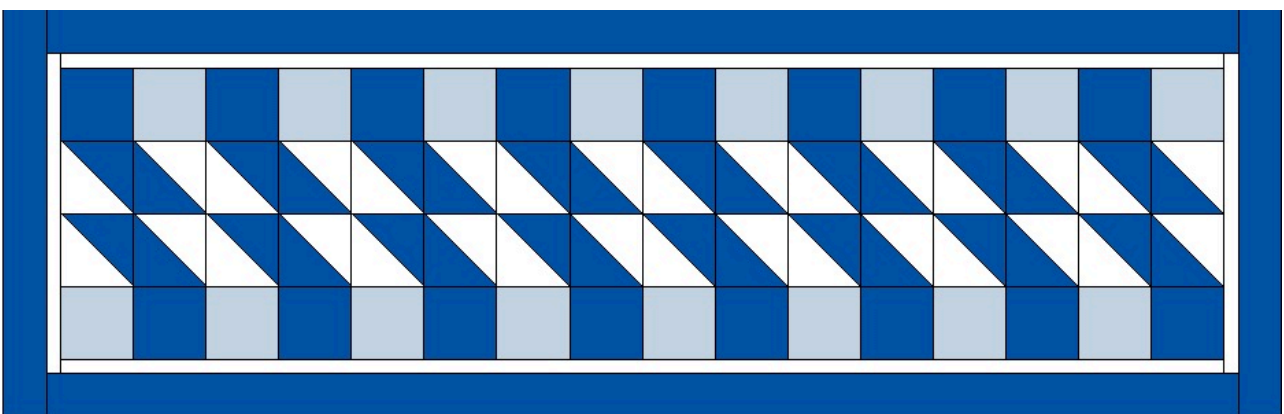
4. Sew the short (white) border strips to the ends of the table runner.



5. Sew the long (dark blue) border strips to the sides of the table runner.



6. Sew the short (dark blue) border strips to the tops of the table runner.



7. Layer your table topper, batting and backing fabric. Quilt and bind.
