


## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This pattern shows you how to create a table runner using the Jack-in-a-Box quilt block. The instructions on how to create the block are available here:-

WOF = width of fabric
USE A QUARTER INCH SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT




#### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3 x Jack-in-the-Box quilt blocks 10" finished (see general instructions above)
- Black Sashing 4 pcs (1½" x 10½")
- Black Border 2 pcs (½" x 34½")
- Pink Border 2 pcs (2½" x 12½")
- Pink Border 2 pcs (2½" x 38½")
- Batting 1 pc (20" x 42")
- Backing 1 pc (20" x 42")
- Binding 3 strips (2½" x WOF)

NOTE: The backing/batting sizes allow for an extra 2" on all sides - for heavy quilting add more

## STEP 1

Create 3 x Jack-in-the-Box quilt blocks. Each block should measure 10 ½" unfinished




STEP 2

Sew the sashing pieces to the blocks as shown below






Sew the long border pieces to each side.



STEP 4




Sew the small border pieces to the top and bottom as shown.





Sew the long border pieces to the sides as shown.



# STEP 6



Add your backing and batting and quilt. Add binding to complete the table runner.
