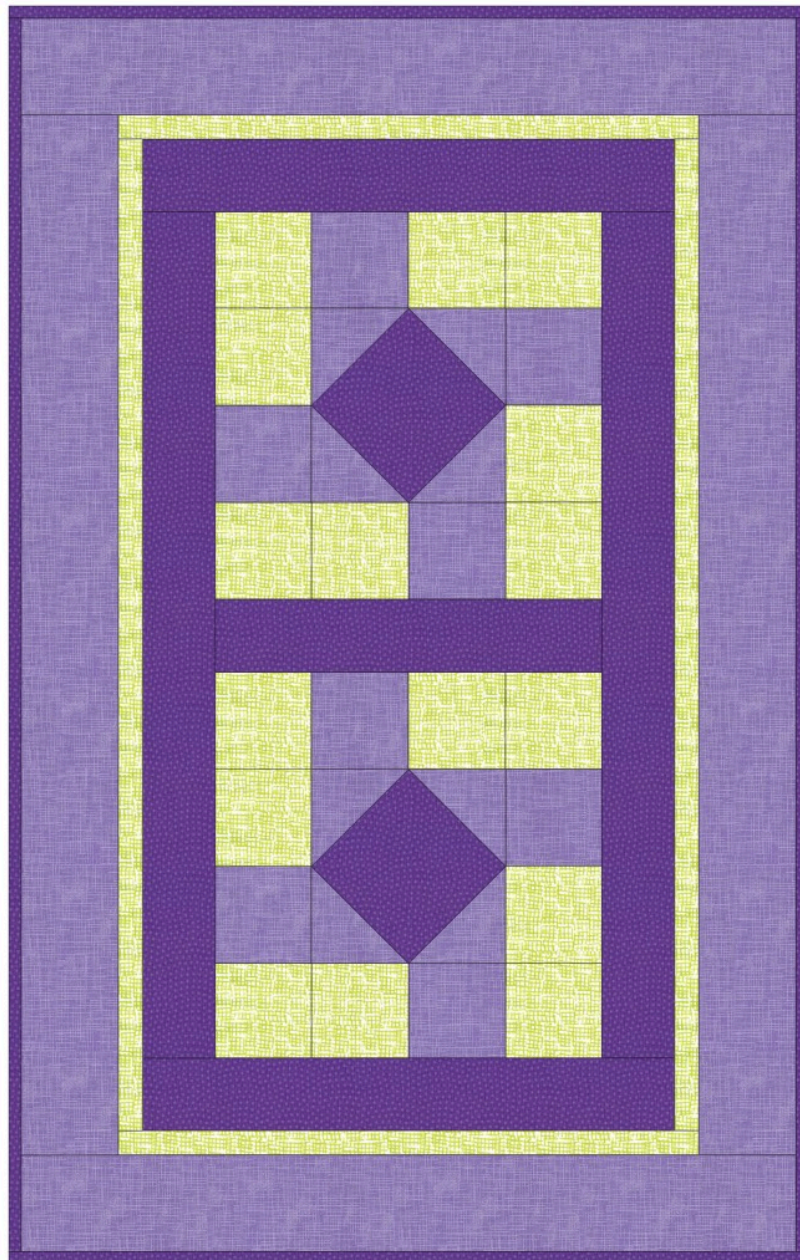

Susannah Table Runner

Finished table runner size - approx 16 1/2" x 25 1/2"



Fabric Requirements

Fabric 1 (Green) - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Fabric 2 (Light Purple) - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Fabric 3 (Dark Purple) - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Backing Fabric - $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Binding - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard (based on $2\frac{1}{4}$ " binding strip)

Batting - approx 18" x 27"

Block Cutting Instructions

These instructions are for an 8" x 8" finished block ($8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished block).

To make the two blocks cut the following:

- Fabric 1: Cut 2 pieces at $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Fabric 2: Cut 16 pieces at $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Fabric 3: Cut 16 pieces at $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

Borders Cutting Instructions

- Border 1 (Dark Purple)
 - Cut 2 strips - 2" x 18"
 - Cut 2 strips - 2" x $11\frac{1}{2}$ "
 - Cut 1 strip - 2" x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Border 2 (Green)
 - Cut 2 strips - 1" x 21"
 - Cut 2 strips - 1" x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Border 3 (Light Purple)
 - Cut 2 strips - $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 22"
 - Cut 2 strips - $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 16"

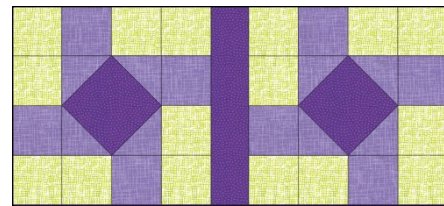
Assembly

Quarter Inch Seam Used

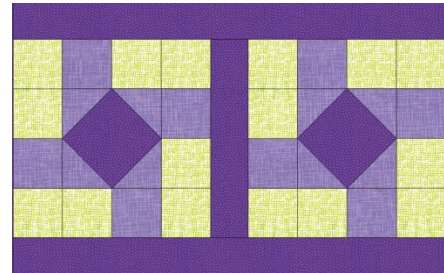
1. To create the blocks, follow the instructions at alandacraft.com

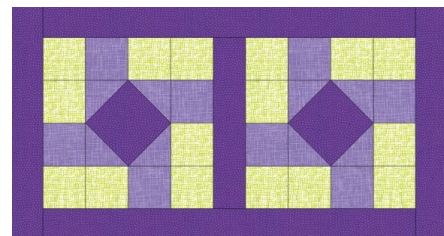
2. Sew the 2" x 8½" (dark purple) strip between the two blocks.



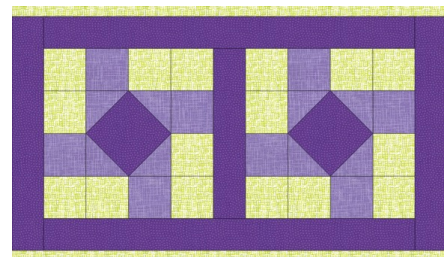
3. Sew the long (dark purple) strips to the sides of the blocks.



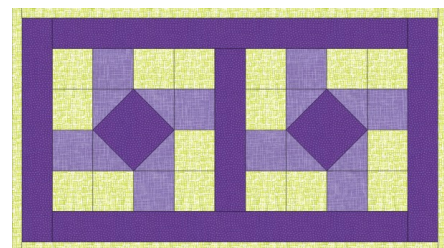
4. Sew the short (dark purple) strips to the ends of the blocks.



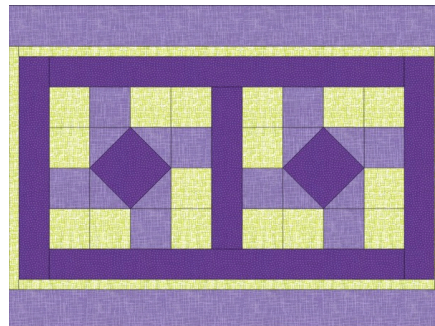
5. Sew the long (green) strips to the sides of the table topper.



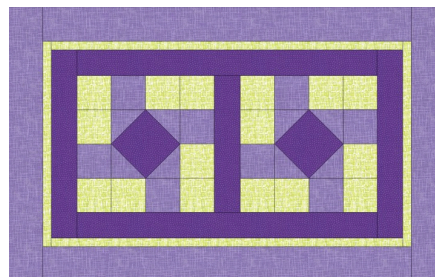
6. Sew the short (green) strips to the tops of the table topper.



7. Sew the long (light purple) strips to the sides of the table topper.



8. Sew the short (light purple) strips to the sides of the table topper.



9. Layer your table topper, batting and backing fabric. Quilt and bind.
